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### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

This scheme provides 50% concessional cancer treatment to cancer patients who have a family income of less than INR 2,00,000 per annum. This scheme is designed to support patients with different types of cancer.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Government State

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

This scheme provides 50% of the total concessional treatment cost to cancer patients.

### 03/ Eligibility

- Annual family income is up to INR 2,00,000
- Applicant must reside in Gujarat

### 04/ Application Process

- Get the Application Form from the desk of an empanelled hospital, or through the link here — <https://www.gcriindia.org/Download/Lower%20Income%20Group%20Affidavit.pdf>
- Fill in the form and attach the required documents.
- Submit the completed form and necessary documents at the hospital desk.

### 05/ Claims

50% of the bill is directly waived from the patient's total bill raised.  
The government will provide 50% of the treatment cost directly to the hospital.

## 02 / Assistance for Occupational Disease, Building and Other Construction Workers

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The scheme provides financial assistance up to a maximum limit of INR 3,00,000 for 15 types of occupational diseases and 23 types of serious injuries to construction workers.

Those suffering from these diseases are provided with a total of up to INR 3,00,000 for treatment, free medical treatment under normal circumstances, assistance of INR 1,500 per month during treatment, and financial assistance of up to INR 3,000 per month to those who are 90 - 100% disabled.

#### 01.2/ Type

#### 01.3/ States Covered

- Government State      Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

- The scheme will provide financial assistance of up to a maximum limit of INR 3,00,000 for 15 types of occupational diseases and 23 types of serious injuries to construction workers.
- The Applicant will receive free medical treatment and monthly assistance of INR 1500 during treatment under normal circumstances, if they have less than 90% disability.
- The Applicant will receive free medical treatment and monthly assistance of INR 3,000 in case they have a 90 - 100% disability.

### 03/ Eligibility

Registered construction workers who suffer from identified occupational diseases.

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The scheme provides financial assistance to destitute older persons who are above 60 years of age.

If a person has a disability of more than 75%, the Applicant should be above 45 years of age. The Applicant should also not have a son over 21 years of age, unless the son is mentally impaired or has a serious disease, such as cancer or tuberculosis.

#### 01.2/ Type

#### 01.3/ States Covered

- Government State      Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

- For Applicant's aged between 60 and 79 years — INR 1000 pension per month.
- For Applicant's aged above 80 years — INR 1250 pension per month.

### 03/ Eligibility

- The Applicant should be a male or female person who is 60 years old or older.
- The Applicant should also not have a son over 21 years of age, unless the son is mentally impaired or has a serious disease, such as cancer or tuberculosis.
- If a person has a disability of more than 75%, the Applicant should be above 45 years of age.
- The Applicant's annual income should not be more than INR 1,20,000 if they are from a rural area and INR 1,50,000 if they are from an urban area.
- The Applicant should have been a permanent resident of Gujarat for the past 10 years.

### 04/ Application Process

- The Application Form can be collected from the Mamlatdar Office, Prant Office, and Janseva Kendra of the Collector Office in the district.
- The Application Form, along with the required documents, has to be submitted in the Mamlatdar Office, Prant Office, Janseva Kendra of the Collector Office in the district.
- The Application can also be completed online from the Village Level (VCE) Gram Panchayat. Application Form — <https://digitalsevasetu.gujarat.gov.in/SchemPortal/ServiceGroup.aspx>
- Mamlatdars are authorised to approve or disapprove the application forms after due verification.
- The money order can be transferred through a bank account or post account.

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

This scheme is for patients who belong to a Scheduled Caste (SC) category, providing benefits in the form of free medical treatment for cancer. The patient will get benefits based on their annual income.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Government State

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

- 100% of free treatment will be provided to a patient if their annual family income is less than INR 1,50,000.
- 50% of free treatment will be provided to a patient if their annual family income is more than INR 1,50,000.

### 03/ Eligibility

- Resident of Gujarat
- Must belong to an SC category
- No person shall be eligible to claim this financial aid more than once

### 04/ Application Process

Fill up the Application Form available at the hospital and attach the necessary supporting documents (detailed below).

After the case is approved, the payment is directly transferred to the hospital.

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The Chief Minister Relief Fund (CMRF) in Gujarat is a fund that provides financial assistance to needy patients for the treatment of various diseases, including cancer. The Fund is administered by the Revenue Department of the Gujarat Government.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Chief Minister Relief Fund

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

This scheme provides financial assistance worth up to 33% of the total treatment cost.

### 03/ Eligibility

- Patient should be a resident of Gujarat
- Patient should not have an income above INR 2,00,000
- Patient should not be getting help from any other scheme or donor

### 04/ Application Process

- Fill in the Application Form addressed to the Chief Minister's Office (CMO).
- Submit the Application Form along with the necessary supporting documents.

### 05/ Claims

Once an application is received, it is considered, and disbursements are made at the sole discretion of the Chief Minister, considering the availability of funds and prior commitments of the CMRF.

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESIC) provides medical facilities to the insured person and their families.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Employee State Insurance Scheme

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Gujarat

### 02/ Benefits

- ESIC provides reasonable medical care for the self and family from the first day of entering into insurable employment.
- Assistance differs for medical, disability, unemployment, funeral costs, sickness, rehabilitation, and old age care.

### 03/ Eligibility

The Applicant must be the insured person or a family member of the insured person.

### 04/ Application Process

- The bill will be submitted by the Empanelled Centre for payment to the Medical Superintendent concerned with necessary supporting documents immediately after completion of treatment in respect of Employee State Insurance (ESI) beneficiaries referred/permitted by the respective Medical Superintendents.
- The Medical Superintendents shall, however, ensure the release of payment within 3 working days after the submission of the bills by the tie-up hospitals. Three days include the processing of bills by Medical Superintendents and the release of payment by the Accounts Branch concerned.
- The Empanelled Centre shall directly charge the individuals for telephone charges and extra diet charges, so incurred by the patient or any of his family members during their stay in the Empanelled Centre.

### 05/ Claims

- Employees must show their ESIC ID card issued by their employer at the hospital.
- The hospital will then process the application for verification and approval.
