# Healthcare Schemes in Madhya Pradesh

A Compendium  
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### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The Rajya Bimari Sahayta Nidhi provides grants to those who are part of the Below Poverty Line category and require major surgical procedures within and outside the state on application.

The scheme covers 21 types of diseases and provides financial assistance between INR 25,000 and INR 2,00,000.

#### 01.2/ Type

- State Flagship Scheme

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Madhya Pradesh

### 02/ Benefits

The scheme provides financial assistance between INR 25,000 and INR 2,00,000

### 03/ Eligibility

- The Applicant should be domiciled in Madhya Pradesh
- The Applicant should belong to a Below Poverty Line category
- The Applicant should have a disease which is stated in the listed diseases

### 04/ Application Process

- The application form can be collected from the below-mentioned offices — District Hospitals, Office of District Chief Medical and Health Officer, Office of the District Collector and Office of District Civil Surgeon.
- The Applicant has to submit the filled-up application in the name of the Director of Public Health and submit it to the district office of the collector, along with a Below Poverty Line (BPL) Card and a Domicile Certificate.
- After giving away the Domicile Certificate and BPL Papers, the application will be forwarded by the collector to the civil surgeon of the district. The civil surgeon will be responsible for stating the disease and the amount of financial assistance needed for the treatment. There must be a mention of the patient's economy class in the application form.
- In the next step the application form will be sent to the Secretary of State Illness Assistance Fund (SIAF). The Secretary will scrutinise the application whether the information is best fitted with the guidelines of SIAF or not.
- After the proper scrutiny, the application will be sent to the Subcommittee under the Department of State Health and Family Welfare, which will evaluate and approve or reject the grant.
- Following approval from the department, the amount for treatment will be sanctioned to a certain hospital.

The SIAF assistance amount cheque is provided directly to the hospital or institution where the approved case is referred.

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### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

This scheme supports citizens who are victims of the 1984 Bhopal Gas Tragedy and are suffering from any type of disease. These services are available in all government hospitals of Bhopal.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Government State

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Madhya Pradesh

### 02/ Benefits

The scheme benefits include free treatment in designated government hospitals.

### 03/ Eligibility

- Should be a citizen of Madhya Pradesh
- Should be a victim of the Bhopal Gas Tragedy

### 04/ Application Process

- Go to a designated hospital or health centre that provides services to Bhopal Gas Tragedy survivors.
- Explain your situation to the hospital staff and provide them with the necessary documents to support your claim. They will guide you through the further process.
- Once your eligibility is confirmed, the hospital will conduct a medical examination to assess your health condition and identify any gas-related ailments.
- Based on the examination results, the hospital will send an estimate to the respective department for approval.
- Once they receive approval, treatment will start immediately.

### 05/ Claims

The benefit amount is directly paid to the hospitals by the government.

#### 01.1/ About

The Chief Minister's Relief Fund (CMRF) in Madhya Pradesh is a contingency fund set up by the state government to provide immediate relief to people affected by natural calamities, accidents, or serious illnesses.

The CMRF is not a part of the state budget, but it is administered by the state government.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Chief Minister Relief Fund

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Madhya Pradesh

### 02/ Benefits

The scheme covers treatment costs of up to INR 1,00,000.

### 03/ Eligibility

- Below Poverty Line (BPL) Card Holders
- Ration Card Holders
- Non-Tax Payers

### 04/ Application Process

- Collect an Application Form from your nearest District Collector's Office, or by contacting the details on the page — <https://www.mponline.gov.in/Portal/Services/CMRF/index.html>
- Fill out the application form completely and accurately.
- Attach the required documents with the application form.
- Submit the application form to the nearest District Collector's Office or any nearby government hospital.
- The application will be sent by the hospital to the Chief Minister's office. Once approved, the benefit will be disbursed.

### 01/ Overview

#### 01.1/ About

The Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESIC) provides monetary and medical benefits in case of sickness, maternity, temporary or permanent physical disability, or death due to employment injury resulting in loss of wages or earning capacity.

#### 01.2/ Type

- Employee State Insurance Scheme

#### 01.3/ States Covered

Madhya Pradesh

### 02/ Benefits

- The scheme provides 70% of average daily wages in cash during medical leave for up to 91 days in two consecutive benefit periods.
- ESIC provides reasonable medical care for the insured person and their family from day one of entering into insurable employment.

### 03/ Eligibility

- The employee or worker's monthly salary cannot be more than INR 21,000, or INR 25,000 for those with disabilities
- The employee's age should be between 18 years to 60 years

### 04/ Application Process

- Visit the ESIC Madhya Pradesh website — <https://www.esic.gov.in/>
- Click on the "Online Services" tab.
- Click on the "New Registration" link.
- Select the "Employee Registration" option, depending on your requirement.
- Fill in the online application form and submit it.
- You will receive a confirmation email or SMS.
- Click on the link provided in the email or SMS to verify your registration.
- Once your registration is verified, you can log in to the ESIC Madhya Pradesh portal and access the services offered.

### 05/ Claims

- Employees must show their ESIC ID card issued by their employer at the hospital.
- The hospital will then process the application for verification and approval.
