Eligibility**

- Patient till 19 years of age.
- The fund sanction depends on a case study conducted by the medical advisory.

Application Process**

- Fill in the Patient Information Sheet (this will be provided by Cankids at the time of admission or inquiry).
- Attach the required documents, like medical reports, treatment plans, and an estimate certificate from the doctor.
- Provide all documents to the social worker who will submit and present the case to the medical committee meeting for further approval.

Payment to be released within 45 days after case approval.

- For bone marrow transplants, there is a maximum assistance amount of INR 8,00,000

- Above 18 years of age
- Indian citizen
- From a low-income group
- Should be referred by a Tata Empanelled Hospital or by a Doctor
- The patient should not have received financial assistance from other sources for cancer treatment

- Below the age of 18 years.
- Patients with an annual family income of less than INR 2,00,000
- Patients who are covered under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) will not be considered eligible for a medical grant under this fund.
- The Patient should have a good prognosis of 60% and above.
- Patients with immediate family members who are government employees covered under the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), or Employees State Insurance Scheme (ESIS) are not eligible
