01.1/ About

The Group Medclaim Insurance Policy (Raj Medclaim) was started by the department for newly recruited state government employees who were recruited on January 01, 2004, and after.

01.2/ Type

- State Insurance

01.3/ States Covered

Rajasthan

02/ Benefits

The scheme covers treatment support of up to INR 3,00,000. This applies to conditions such as –

- Coronary Artery Surgery
- Cancer
- Renal Failure (i.e. failure of both kidneys)
- Stroke
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Meningitis
- Major Organ Transplant like kidney, lung, pancreas, bone marrow, etc.

03/ Eligibility

The Medclaim Policy applies to State employees appointed from January 01, 2004 and onwards.

04/ Application Process

State government employees are automatically covered under the scheme.

05/ Claims

- Any claim under this Policy should be sent to the TPA, with the full particulars.
- All supporting documents relating to the claim must be filed with TPA/GIF within 7 days from the date of discharge from the hospital.
- In case of post-hospitalisation, treatment (limited to 60 days), all claim documents should be submitted within 7 days after completion of such treatment.

- Claim Form
- Duly filled and signed Doctor’s recommendation for hospital admission
- Discharge Card issued by the hospital
- Original of the Final Hospital Bill
- Medical Investigation Reports
- Medical Bills with supporting prescriptions invoice for surgical implants
- FIR in case of road accidents
- A cancelled cheque to provide account details in case the insurer is paying the reimbursement through NEFT

01.1/ About

The Government of Rajasthan has been providing medical facilities to Hon'ble MLAs, Ex-MLAs, State Government employees and pensioners through provisions under various rules, schemes and medical insurance policies. State autonomous bodies, boards, and corporations provide medical facilities through their own regulations.

01.2/ Type

- State Insurance

01.3/ States Covered

Rajasthan

02/ Benefits

- Cashless IPD or Day Care, OPD (up to INR 20,000), and medical care facilities as per CGHS rates (or other rates as decided by competent authority).
- Treatment up to INR 5,00,000 per family on floater basis.
- Additional expenses, related to catastrophic illness, of up to INR 5,00,000 per family.
- Travelling allowance for journeys undertaken for medical treatment, as applicable by TA Rules.
- Ambulance Charges

This applies to treatments including –

- Chemotherapy
- Radiation therapy
- Surgery
- Any other prescribed treatment for cancer

03/ Eligibility

- The Applicant must be a permanent resident of Rajasthan
- The Applicant must be an MLA, ex-MLA, state government employee, or pensioner

04/ Application Process

- Go to the official scheme website – <https://rghs.rajasthan.gov.in/RGHS/home/>
- On the homepage, click the 'SSO Login' tab on the right hand side.
- On this new page, select your category from the following options – Citizen, Udyog, or Government Employees
- Next, select the relevant option from the given options – Janaadhaar or Bhamashah.
- On the new page that opens, enter all the required information.
- Upload the required documents.
- Click submit.

40 district drug stores have been set up at the district headquarters to distribute medicines in all medical institutions.

Eligibility**

- Resident of Rajasthan
- Should be an indoor or outdoor patient in a government hospital
- Should possess a family Jan Aadhaar Card

**04/
Application Process**

- Locate the nearest authorised healthcare facility participating in the Free Cancer Medicines Scheme. This can be a government hospital or a designated cancer treatment centre in Rajasthan.
- Obtain a medical record confirming the diagnosis of cancer and the prescription for the medicine/drug from the hospital.
- Collect all the required documents to support your application.
- Obtain free medicines from the medical store of the healthcare facility.
- Note – online appointments can also be taken by getting registered through Jan Aadhaar on OPD and IPD in any government hospital.

Claims**

On showing the prescription and other supporting documents, the free drugs, medicines, or sutures may be availed.

06/ Documents Required

- Proof of residence in Rajasthan (such as a Domicile Certificate or Ration Card)
- Identification Documents (such as a Janaadhaar or Aadhaar Number or a Voter ID)
- Medical Records confirming the diagnosis of cancer
- Income Certificate or Proof of Economic Status
- Patient's Registration Slip

01.1/ About

This scheme provides assistance for cancer treatment at the Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital and Research Centre (BMCHRC), Jaipur, a NABH and NABL accredited institution. The BMCHRC is a cancer speciality hospital which serves all types of cancer patients from different backgrounds.

There are no specific restrictions or limitations based on age, stage of cancer, or treatment status.

For Applicants who belong to a Below Poverty Line (BPL) category, the scheme will cover 25% of their cancer treatment cost. This includes –

- Surgical Oncology
- Medical Oncology
- Radiation Oncology
- Haematology Oncology
- Anesthesiology
- Neuro Onco Surgery
- Geriatric Oncology
- Radiology
- Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery
- Nuclear Medicine
- Pathology departments

- Ostomy Clinic
- Dietary Services
- Physiotherapy
- Dental Surgery (specifically, the scheme covers the cost of preventive dental care for cancer patients at BMCHRC, especially those who require oral hygiene maintenance before cancer treatment).

01.1/ About

This scheme provides medical assistance to accident victims and general assistance for other purposes for up to INR 1,50,000.

Medical assistance is given to non-Below Poverty Line (BPL), low income group people of the state in both government and identified-private hospitals.

01.2/ Type

01.3/ States Covered

- Chief Minister Relief Fund

Rajasthan

02/ Benefits

- The scheme covers all types of cancer treatment and bone marrow transplants.
- Government hospitals –
40% of hospitalisation costs will be covered, or a maximum INR 1,50,000.
- Recognised private hospitals –
30% of hospitalisation costs will be covered, or a maximum of INR 90,000, whichever amount is lower.
- Exception –
In the South East Asia Institute for Thalassemia, Jaipur –
The 100% hospitalisation cost amount of up to INR 7,00,000 is sanctioned as an exception, by relaxing the Chief Minister’s Relief Fund rules for bone marrow transplants for children suffering from thalassemia disease in Rajasthan whose family annual income is up to INR 2,50,000.

03/ Eligibility

- The applicant should not be a BPL Card holder.
- The annual income of the family should not be greater than INR 2,00,000.
- The applicant cannot be a beneficiary of the Ayushman Bharat Mahatma Gandhi Rajasthan Swasthya Bima Yojana (ABMGRSBY).

04/ Application Process

- Visit an empanelled government hospital and get the application form. The Application Form and details on the necessary supporting documents can also be found here –

- Fill in the complete application and submit to the Rajasthan Chief Minister’s Relief Fund –

- Assistance is accepted from the date of receipt of application.

Claims**

- On receipt of the complete application form, financial aid is approved by the concerned hospital and a copy of the acceptance is sent to the patient by post.
- The acceptance letter can be printed out. A computer-generated SMS is also sent to the patient.
- Assistance is accepted from the date of receipt of the application. In case the application is submitted before discharge while being admitted to the hospital, assistance is accepted from the date of admission.
- Assistance is not accepted if the application is received after completion of treatment/discharge.
- In case the patient applies while admitted and after being discharged in a short period, the hospital returns the sanctioned aid amount, and the aid amount is paid through the concerned district collector.

Required**

- Medical expenditure letter from a government or recognized hospital at CGHS rates.
- An original declaration letter of family income (including income of major sons) in the form prescribed by the Revenue Department Appendix-I, J, K (Form - 4)
- Ration Card (a separate affidavit is necessary if the patient’s name is not mentioned on the Ration Card)

01.1/ About

The main objective of the Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESIC) is to provide health care facilities to employees who earn a monthly salary of INR 21,000 or less, and are part of various industrial, commercial, private, educational, medical, and other forms of organisations which employ 10 or more employees.

01.2/ Type

01.3/ States Covered

02/ Benefits

All types of treatment are covered under this scheme.

03/ Eligibility

- All employees working and earning up to INR 21,000 per month are eligible for the ESIC scheme.
- This includes all sorts of workers – permanent, temporary, and contractual workers.
- All establishments having 10 or more employees need to register themselves with the ESIC scheme.
- The scheme applies to all types of employment businesses and is applied to the whole of Rajasthan.
- Employees who are covered under other health insurance schemes or any government-funded health insurance schemes are not eligible for the ESIC scheme.
- Employers are required to their employees and are required to pay their contributions.
- There is a regulation for voluntary coverage to cover employees who are not eligible for mandatory coverage under the ESIC scheme.

04/ Application Process

- When going for treatment, ESIC authorised medical practitioners and hospitals are available in all major cities and towns in Rajasthan. Provide your ESIC-Insured Person Card which is given by the employer. The medical practitioner will diagnose and prescribe treatment for your illness.
- They will issue a medical certificate or prescription which should be retained for claiming reimbursement of medical expenses. Submit a claim of reimbursement of medical expenses to the ESIC office within 15 days from the date of discharge or completion of treatment. Attach all the necessary documents which are essential for the claim of the ESIC scheme.
- The ESIC claim should be submitted by the employer and the ESIC office will process the claim and reimburse medical expenses to the employee's bank account.
