The New Health Insurance Scheme (NHIS) launched for state government employees and pensioners provides health insurance including cashless treatment and reimbursement of medical expenses in the hospitals. There are varying premium amounts and benefits offered to employees and pensioners, and the insurance is renewed every year.

The premium amounts are deducted from their salary/pension. It covers general medical treatments, with the option for escalated financial assistance for serious disorders and therapies such as Cancer Treatment and Bone Marrow Transplants.

It is a complementary benefit for employees and pensioners in Tamil Nadu.

- Financial Assistance up to 75% of the expenses or INR 1,00,000 whichever is less is granted to those who apply with the documents related to treatment taken for ailments approved under the scheme

- Financial Assistance up to INR 5,00,000 for a block of four years for the approved treatments taken and surgeries undergone
- Financial Assistance up to INR 10,00,000 for special approved treatments taken and surgeries undergone.
- Financial Assistance for approved medical treatments and surgeries on a cashless basis in Network Hospitals and on reimbursement basis from Non-Network Hospitals for Emergency Care or following an accident.

03/ Eligibility

The beneficiary should be an employee/pensioner or their dependant of the Tamil Nadu State Government.

04/ Application Process

Enrolment is compulsory for employees and pensioners, and employers should contact them for enrolment based on their employees database.

Tamil Nadu — 01 / New Health Insurance Scheme

- The premium is INR 10 per month for employees and INR 497 per month for pensioners, which shall be deducted from their monthly salary/pension.
- Upon registration, the insurance company/third-party administrator shall issue a
- New Health Insurance Scheme ID Card/Eligibility Card which is to be carried by the beneficiary for treatment.
- The identity cards will be distributed through the Pension Pay Officer, Chennai/ Treasury Officers/Sub-Treasury Officers concerned.
- The ID card (e-Card) provision should be made available to all the beneficiaries to download from the designated website of the scheme.

05/ Claims

- The Network Hospitals empanelled for CASHLESS facility under this scheme shall be approached for availing medical assistance for the approved treatments and surgeries. The Beneficiary shall approach the Insurance Office of the Network Hospital which is dealing with CASHLESS treatment. In case of any discrepancy, they can contact the District Level Coordinator/District Level Nodal Officer/TollFree Number/State Level Coordinator/State Level Nodal Officer in this regard.
- Network Hospital shall identify, direct, and register all the beneficiaries holding eligibility cards.
- The Network Hospital shall send the pre-authorization request immediately to the Insurance Company/Third Party Administrator with ID Card proof or PPO with an Authorization Form for the approved treatments and surgeries to be undertaken so that pre-authorization approval is given by the Insurance Company/Third Party Administrator.
- If the approved treatments and surgeries are covered under this scheme, an approval of pre-authorization would be issued to the concerned Network Hospital enabling CASHLESS facility for the Eligible Medical Expenses to be incurred subject to the Ceiling Criteria.
- The Beneficiary should sign the final authorization letter approved by the Insurance Company/TPA in which the final authorization amount shall be provided to the Beneficiary.
- The Network Hospital shall obtain the signature of the Beneficiary on the approval of the final authorization letter and after obtaining the signature, the same shall be sent to the Insurance Company/Third Party Administrator by the Network Hospital at the time of claim settlement.
- In case of emergency, if the beneficiary does not have the NHIS card at the time of admission, an emergency number from the insurer can be obtained by the hospital and proceed with the treatment so that there won't be any delay in initiating the treatment. In that case, the pre-authorization may be submitted within 48 hours.
- Nodal Officers/Coordinators should help the beneficiaries to coordinate with the hospitals for obtaining pre-authorization, claim settlement, and follow-up.

Additionally, the Government has sanctioned INR 10 crore for creating a corpus fund under the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) since 2012 to enable the needy and poor to undergo high-cost surgical treatment like liver, renal, and bone marrow transplantation. These high-cost treatments are applicable for Palliative Chemotherapy, Breast Cancer, Myeloid Leukaemia, and Head and Neck Cancer.

- The Medical Superintendents shall, however, ensure the release of payment within 3 (three) working days after submission of the bills by the tie-up hospitals. Three days include the processing of bills by Medical Superintendents and the release of payment by the Accounts Branch concerned.
- The Empaneled Centre shall directly charge the individuals for telephone charges and extra diet charges, so incurred by the patient or any of his family members during their stay in the empanelled Centre.
