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01/ Overview

01.1/ About

This scheme provides low-cost pathological diagnostic services and imaging services to the citizens. The District Hubs conduct over 60 types of tests with high-end diagnostic equipment, including auto-analyzers, digital X-rays, ultrasound scan machines, and mammograms. Imaging services are provided through mini-hubs.

The X-ray, ultrasound, and imaging services may help detect the following diseases —

- Oncology/Cancer
- Lung Cancer (Pulmonology)
- Breast Cancer
- Renal Cancer (Nephrology)
- Colon & Rectal Cancer (Gastroenterology)
- Blood Cancer (Haematology)
- Growth Hormone Deficiency
- Sickle Cell Disease

02/ Benefits

The scheme offers free diagnostic services, thereby offering savings ranging from INR 500 to INR 10,000 (compared to the cost of such testing at private labs).

03/ Eligibility

The scheme is available to all citizens of Telangana.

04/ Application Process

- Visit the nearest Basthi Dawakhana, Palle Dawakhana, PHCs, CHCs, Area hospital, or District Hospital based on the required diagnostic services.
- The registration process will be done by the concerned member of the centre
- A Sample or Test will be collected/conducted and sent to the nearest District or Mini-hub or lab.
- If the service required involves auto-analyzers, digital X-rays, ultrasound scan machines, or mammograms, then the sample will be sent to a mini-hub. All the imaging services will take place at the mini hub itself.
- Samples will later be taken to Central Labs where accession, regression, and verification will be done.
- The online report will be generated and sent back to the mini hubs and district hubs.

02 / Telangana State Government Employees and Journalists Health Scheme

01/ Overview

01.1/ About

The Telangana State Government Employees and Journalists Health Scheme is designed to offer cashless treatment to State Government employees, pensioners, and their dependent family members.

It will ipso facto replace the current medical reimbursement system and include extra benefits like post-operative care and the treatment of chronic diseases that don't need to be hospitalised, as well as treatment in hospitals that have been granted empanelled status.

02/ Benefits

- End-to-end cashless service offered through a Network Hospital from the time of reporting of a patient till 10 days post-discharge medication, including complications if any up to 30 days post-discharge, for those patients who undergo a “listed therapy(ies)”.
- Free OP evaluation of patients for listed therapies who may not undergo IP treatment, including consultation and investigations.
- Note — there is no upper limit on the financial coverage and the total cost of treatment of the patient for the enlisted therapies will be covered under the scheme.

03/ Eligibility

- Resident of Telangana
- Serving Employees (All regular State Government Employees. A State Government Employee will have the meaning as defined under the Fundamental Rules.
- Provincialized Employees of Local Bodies
- Retired Employees (All service pensioners, family pensioners without dependents, and re-employed service pensioners.)
The following beneficiaries are not covered —
- Those who are covered under other insurance schemes such as CGHS.
- Members of ESIS, Railways, RTC, Aarogya Bhadratha of Police Department and Aarogya Sahayatha of Prohibition & Excise Department
- Law Officers (including Advocate Generals, State Prosecutors, State Counsels, Government Pleaders, and Public Prosecutors)
- Casual and Daily Paid Workers
- Biological Parents, if adopted parents exist
- All Independent Children
- AIS Officers and AIS Pensioners

**04/
Application Process**

- Approach a Network Hospital kiosk either with a referral card or with a complaint for registration.
- The Medical Coordinator (MEDCO) will register the patient. In case the patient is a child, the patient's identity and complaint are registered. OP is registered and an OP ticket issued.
- The patient is forwarded to the OP and gets counselled to ascertain their eligibility under the scheme.
- After an initial evaluation of the patient, the patient is admitted if needed and evaluated further. The patient may be evaluated as an out-patient initially and after ascertaining the diagnosis and finalisation treatment mode admitted and converted to 'in-patient' in the online workflow.
- If the patient is found to be suffering from a condition present in the Listed Therapies, MEDCO shall submit the pre-authorization through the Trust portal within 24 hours.
- If the patient is found to be suffering from diseases other than those that cannot be managed in the NWH or not covered in the Listed Therapies, they shall be counselled and referred to the nearest suitable Hospital for further management.
- The MEDCO shall upload all the relevant documents and send the case for pre-authorization.
- The NWH shall render complete treatment to the patient after obtaining pre-authorization.

The Network Hospital will raise the claim 10 days after the satisfactory discharge of the patient.

This scheme provides financial assistance up to INR 10,00,000 in a year for the treatment of serious ailments requiring hospitalisation and surgery. It also provides financial coverage of up to 10,00,000 for high end procedures per family.

Application Process**

- Approach your Network Hospital, Area Hospitals, District Hospital, PHC, or Health Camp.
- Produce your Ration Card to be able to avail of the scheme benefit.

**05/
Claims**

- At Network Hospitals, Area Hospitals, or District Hospitals —
- An Aarogyamithra will facilitate the patient to the Medical coordinator (MEDCO) with a Registration Form.
 - A primary screening will be done by MEDCO. If a specialist consultation is needed, the patient will be referred to the concerned specialist.
 - MEDCO will upload the OP/IP status of the patient and obtain online preauthorization for the beneficiary by uploading all the required documents like the White Ration Card, patient photo, and other necessary reports like x-rays, a surgical profile, CT Scan, etc.
- At a Primary Health Center —
- The patient is sent to the MEDCO for provisional diagnosis. After screening by the Medical Officer, the details of the patients are entered by the PHC Aarogyamithra in the RTR Form under the “Referred” and “Non-Referred” categories.
 - For Non-Referred Categories, a patient is sent as OP with medicines provided by the PHC.
 - For Referred Categories, a Referral Card is given to the patients with necessary counselling, and the patient is facilitated either to a Government Hospital for further tests or to a Network Hospital depending upon the advice of the doctor.

At Monthly Health Camps —

- Every month, mobile screening camps are held to identify patients with symptoms who are then prescribed diagnostic tests.
- Once the cancer is diagnosed, they are immediately sent to a higher cancer treatment facility for treatment.

The Basavatarakam Indo American Cancer Hospital & Research Institute (BIACH) is a not-for-profit cancer treatment and research centre. This scheme offers screening and treatment support for cancer patients from weaker financial backgrounds at the centre.

Benefits**

The scheme covers all types of cancer treatments, as the hospital has all the required infrastructure and capacity to treat cancer. This includes –

- PET CT with Cyclotron, Gallium Scan, and Gamma Camera Scan.
A Radiation Therapy Unit, which includes 6 Linear Accelerators, Varian Novalis Tx Rapidarc with VMAT and Brain Lab, and exclusive big bore CT for simulation and 4D planning, offering a full set of radiation therapy procedures, like 3D Conformal Therapy and Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy, Image guided Radiation therapy, and Stereotactic Radiosurgery.
- Stereotactic Body Radiation Therapy, SRS, SRT and Intraoperative Radiotherapy.
Other services available include –
- Oncology – Surgical, Medical, Radiation, Gynaec, Pediatric, Neuro
- Nuclear Medicine
- PET-CT scan cyclotron,transfusion medicine,mobile screening unit.

Eligibility**

- Must be from a Low-Income Group
- Aarogyasri and Employee Health Scheme patients are covered under this Scheme.

**04/
Application Process**

- Contact the social department of the hospital for a registration form from a Medico Social Worker.
- The Patient will receive a Medical Record Number.
- The Registration Fee of INR 150 will be collected. This is valid for a lifetime.

Claims**

Claims are settled internally and are adjusted against the final bill, depending upon the approvals.

- Request an application for the programme and correctly complete the Form that is provided.

Claims are directly settled with the hospitals and beneficiaries in some cases by the government. All details are provided during the application process directly.

The Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESIC) provides medical facilities to an insured person and their families.

01.2/ Type

Employee State
Insurance Scheme

01.3/ States Covered

Telangana

02/ Benefits

Benefits differ for medical, disability, unemployment, funeral costs, sickness, rehabilitation, and old age care.

03/ Eligibility

An insured member or a family member of an insured member is eligible.

04/ Application Process

- The bill will be submitted by the Empanelled Centre for payment to the Medical Superintendent concerned with necessary supporting documents immediately after completion of treatment in respect of Employee State Insurance (ESI) beneficiaries referred/permitted by the respective Medical Superintendents.
- The Medical Superintendents shall, however, ensure the release of payment within 3 working days after the submission of the bills by the tie-up hospitals. Three days include the processing of bills by Medical Superintendents and the release of payment by the Accounts Branch concerned.
- The Empanelled Centre shall directly charge the individuals for telephone charges and extra diet charges, so incurred by the patient or any of his family members during their stay in the Empanelled Centre.

05/ Claims

Employees must show their ESIC ID card issued by their employer at the hospital. The hospital will then process the application for verification and approval.
